



NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

BALANCES ON CIPRO CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS

Over the past year a tendency was noted that certain CIPRO Customers deposit or maintain large amounts of money in the CIPRO bank account – amounts that are in excess of their immediate need to pay for services. CIPRO Management is concerned about this practice as it could, *inter alia*, lead to CIPRO finding itself in contravention with the Banks Act, 1990, the Financial Intelligence Centre Act, 2001, and other relevant legislation.

In the interest of good governance, customers are informed that only deposits linked to transactions should be carried out and the related transactions should be performed within two (2) months. Failure to comply with the above will result in monies deposited being refunded back to the clients.

During February 2010 CIPRO will identify all unutilized funds as at 31 January 2010, and initiate a process to refund all such monies.
